The Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a, states in part: No agency shall disclose any record which is contained in a system of records by any means of communication to any person, or to another agency, except pursuant to a written request by, or with the prior consent of, the individual/Agency to whom the records pertains [1] There are specific exceptions for the records allowing the use of personal records [2] ... The Privacy Act mandates that each United States Government agency have in place an administrative and physical security system to prevent the unauthorized release of personal records.
