Dear Senator Kyl and Senator McCain:

We, the undersigned counsel and representatives of parties to the Navajo-Hopi Little Colorado River Water Rights Settlement Agreement have reviewed the attached Navajo-Hopi Little Colorado River Water Rights Settlement Agreement and the federal legislation (S.2109) introduced in the Senate on February 14, 2012 ("Settlement Documents"). Based on our participation in the negotiations and/or our review of the Settlement Documents, we, at this time, intend to express our support for the Settlement Documents and plan to submit them to our governing bodies for formal consideration, subject to review and approval of the exhibits. The governing bodies, however, must still conduct a final review of the Settlement Documents and make an independent decision.
