The Hopi High School radio broadcast, news video and journalism clubs are raising money so they can attend the National Journalism Education Association conference in Seattle, WA., April 6-9.

Students attending the national youth media conference will benefit by meeting students from throughout the country and learning more about media techniques. They will also attend sessions by professional broadcast and print journalists.

During the trip, part of the students' grade is interviewing one presenter and one student from another school. Students need to write a 200-word report in five-paragraph format as part of their grade for the trip.

The Seattle JEA requires and expects students to raise \$1,500 to go on the trip., and is due by Feb. 1. Students are also required to put in five hours of volunteer time with a Hopi Foundation approved non-profit agency. The trip will cost approximately \$1,500 per student for airfare, hotel, food and other amenities. Any donation is appreciated. Hopi High is a 501C3 and donations are tax deductible.

## Notice of Proposed Order of Exclusion (Pursuant to Ordinance 46, Title II, Section 46.02.02)

Office of the General Counsel  
The Hopi Tribe

**THE OFFICE OF THE CHAIRMAN, HOPI TRIBE TO:  
Thane Epefanio and Michelle A. Epefanio**

Notice is hereby served upon you, pursuant to the authority of Hopi Tribal Ordinance #46, that I, Chairman of the Hopi Tribe, have reason to believe and do believe that reasons exist that justify the exclusion of you from the Hopi Reservation and that an order of exclusion directed to you should be issued.

There is reason to believe that your continued presence on the Hopi Indian Reservation may be harmful to members of the Hopi Indian Tribe. It is alleged that you violated federal criminal law by committing federal social security fraud; to wit, in or about the 11th Day of October, 2016, you were indicted by a grand jury of the United States District Court for the District of Arizona and charged with violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 371 and charged with "unlawfully, voluntarily, intentionally, and knowingly" conspiring to defraud the United States by deceitful and dishonest means. While working as principal and teacher at the Hopi Mission School and receiving payment of wages for that employment, you both represented to the Federal government of the United States that Michelle Epefanio was disabled and unable to work. Despite your indictment on federal criminal charges, you returned to the Hopi Reservation and Thane Epefanio represented to the parents of the children at the Mission School that you are under no criminal charges other than for traffic offenses. This is serious fraud on the members of the Hopi Tribe, including the students of the Mission School and your continued presence on the reservation may be harmful to the members of the Hopi Indian Tribe.

Under Ordinance #46, you have the right to submit a WRITTEN RESPONSE within fifteen (15) days after service of this Notice; the written response must be delivered to:

You have the right to request a hearing at which you may be represented by counsel; you may present oral and documentary evidence, call witnesses, and offer an explanation as to why your exclusion from the Hopi Indian Reservation should not be ordered. If you wish a hearing, you must do so in writing within fifteen (15) days of this notice. You will be notified of the time and place set for the hearing.

If you do not wish to request a hearing, I will base my decision upon the information provided by the party or parties requesting your exclusion and any written response you have submitted in the manner Indicated above.

## New Representatives take Oath of Office and begin serving on Tribal Council

New Tribal Council Representatives from the Villages of Bacavi, Kykotsmovi and First Mesa were sworn into office and seated on the Hopi Tribal Council to represent their respective Villages at the beginning of the first quarter session on December 1.

Interim Tribal Council Secretary Anita Bahnimptewa read a letter into record from Bacavi Village Governor xxx, certifying Clifford Quotsaquahu as the newly elected Village Representative and extending the term of Lamar Keevama for another two years. They join fellow Village Councilor Ruth Kewanimptewa currently seated on Council.

A letter from the Kykotsmovi Village Election Committee and Village Governor Carlene Quotskuyva was also read into record certifying David Talayumptewa and Jack Harding, Jr. as the newly elected Village Representatives. They replace Miona Kaping and Norman Honani, whose terms expired in November. They join Councilors Antone Honanie and Nada Talayumptewa currently representing their Village on Council.

First Mesa Village Kikmongwi James Tewaguna sent a letter to the Hopi Tribal Council, and read into record by the interim Secretary. In his letter to the Council, Kikmongwi Tewaguna re-appointed Albert Siquah and Wally Youvella, Sr., extending their time to represent the First Mesa Consolidated Villages for another two more years. They join Councilors Dale Siquah and Celestino Youvella, also appointed by the Kikmongwi, to represent the First Mesa Consolidated Villages.

The Council Representatives took their Oath of Office and immediately begin serving their roles as Village Representatives and Legislators of the Hopi Tribal Government.

Currently, the Village of Mishongnovi does not have a Representatives seated on the Tribal Council, although Village Elections were held on October 27. An Official Tally Report submitted to the Hopi Tutuveni shows the following results for Mishongnovi Tribal Council Representatives: Emma Anderson (34 votes), Pansy Edmo (32), Craig Andrews (30) and Rolanda Yoyletsdewa (27). The four candidates received the highest votes, among nine candidates and were elected to represent their Village on Council. No further information was available on when the elected Village representatives would be certified and administered their Oaths of Office to begin their terms on the Hopi Tribal Council.

## Tribal Council approves new enrollment applications bringing total Hopi membership to 14,381

# Hotevilla man sentenced to 37 months for illegally possessing firearms

Phoenix, AZ -- Nicholas Cooper, 32, of Hotevilla, Ariz., was sentenced by U.S. District Judge John J. Tuchi to 37 months’ imprisonment, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Cooper, an enrolled member of the Hopi Tribe, had previously pleaded guilty to being a felon in possession of firearms.

Because he had previously been convicted of a felony, Cooper was prohibited from possessing firearms. In December 2014 and January 2015, Cooper possessed two firearms in violation of this prohibition. One of the firearms he possessed had been stolen from another enrolled member of the Hopi Tribe.

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Bureau of Indian Affairs-Office of Justice Services (Hopi Agency). The prosecution was handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Alexander Samuels, District of Arizona, Phoenix.

The writer’s name must be included with the letter, along with the writer’s address and daytime phone number to aid with verification; the phone number will not be published. Anonymous letters and letters written under pseudonyms will not be published. The Tutuveni reserves the right to edit letters for length and clarity, and may decline to print letters considered potentially libelous or slanderous in nature. Letters should not exceed 500 words.

We are especially interested in articles reporting on local events and activities involving members of the Hopi Tribe. Submission does not guarantee publication. ## LETTERS TO THE EDITOR / OPINIONS / VIEWS / EDITORIALS

Dear Editor,

I noticed that the Tutuveni will no longer be a free “newsletter” or be available online. I am sorry to see this happen. Today, the Hopi worldview is changing due to the immediacy of the Internet and social media. How much of this is real news and what is made up or fake or “yow i””? How much do we rely on what we read to make important decisions? The Hopi Tutuveni as the official newspaper of the Hopi Tribe must step up to make substantial improvements, as I will now pay out of pocket to receive local Hopi news.

One major improvement should be to provide reporting of substantive, in-depth, facts based on research topics of vital interest to the welfare of our community. For example, the Hopi Tribal Council must be held accountable and its proceedings transparent so that the Hopi people know of the critical issues before the tribal government. The components of the tribal organization should share information between the Public Relations, Lobbyist, KUYI and Tutuveni reporters. In other words, don’t be lazy. Go out and seek hard news. We may kill the messenger but we love to hear news, good and bad news.

I support the Hopi Tutuveni as it must be self-sustain-

ing financially but more importantly, to be independent to report news that is critical, relevant and factual to the reader.

To be an informed community we can support local news by subscribing to local newspapers, donating to nonprofit newsrooms, becoming a member at your public broadcasting station and support the local businesses that advertise on community news sites. Build a relationship with your local journalists, give them feedback, tell them what you’d like to see covered and share their stories. Support a mix of media in your life by constructing a diverse media diet with a good mix of alternative news, local, national and international and countervailing points of view.

Hopi blogs to read on Wordpress include: anglesmomentum, Beyondthemesas, Paaqaviinc for alternative Hopi stories as there are many aspiring Hopi writers out there.

I will subscribe to the Hopi Tutuveni but I will expect more than “cut and paste” from other news sources, less advertising and more space to critical, in-depth professional news reporting.

## HOPI TRIBAL HOUSING AUTHORITY HOMEOWNERSHIP PROGRAM

The HTHA Homeownership Program is committed to providing Homeownership opportunities. The Homeownership program is to provide housing services to low/moderate income Hopi families and to permit each applicant the greatest opportunity for the exercise of individual rights, that are compliant with NAHASDA rules and regulations pertaining to the Admission and Continued Occupancy.

The Homeownership program requires an annual income of \$14,000, and cannot exceed the income limits based on family size. The Homeownership program will maintain a waiting list of all applicants with authorized land assignments. When a new project is scheduled to begin, the HTHA will select eligible applicants from the waiting list based on need and other factors using scoring criteria to determine priority, and notification to applicant will be completed accordingly.

HTHA Homeownership Intake & Eligibility Application Process:

(1) It is encouraged that a face to face meeting occur with all the adult members of the household, to ensure that the correct program application(s) are provided and explained in detail, also with the request of addition verification forms that may be required to complete the eligibility determination process.

(2) Assist applicants with information regarding program eligibility, program options and services provided by the Hopi Tribal Housing Authority that would best suit the household needs.

(3) A limited background check will be completed on

all household members over the age of 18, to ensure that the household will not have detrimental effect on other residents due to habits, practices, and criminal activity.

(4) Applicant’s determination of eligibility is made by using the following program requirements and income limits: NAHASDA 80% National AMI Homeownership.

(5) Once and applicant has been determined eligible the household is placed on a waiting list. Homeownership requires an official land assignment from one’s respective village as part of the application process.

(6) Once a project is funded, Land Assignments will then go through a Site Feasibility Study which will initiate the Service Line Agreement (SLA) Process if site is determined feasible.

(7) Eligible Applicants are required to attend the Mandatory Homebuyer Education Training sessions.

(8) If an applicant declines a unit he/she will be moved to the bottom of the waiting list.

(9) If the unit is accepted and the household is still program and income eligible (update is completed at that time), a move-in will be scheduled with RSS.

(10) All applicants must update their application every 12 months for all Programs.

Hopi High boys basketball lost to much larger teams in the Pepsi Tournament in Flagstaff to remain winless in four games. One problem that the Bruins faced is that three players were academically ineligible so the squad only took eight players instead of 11 meaning they didn't have as many subs so the remaining players were worn down.

In the opening round, Camelback High School beat Hopi 74-44. Hopi kept the game close during the first quarter falling behind 16-11. Camelback zoomed ahead 39-22 at halftime. Camelback extended the lead to 60-35 after three quarters. Kyrane Yazzie led the Bruins with 16 points, Jihad Nodman netted nine and Jacob Lim scored eight.

Hopi High Coach Rick Baker said the Bruins held their own in the first half, but Camelback took it to them in the second half. "Their smallest player was taller than our tallest player. We were outsized, but we played the best we could," he said. "Camelback is pretty talented. They have good players and they're tougher than we are. Our man-to-man defense took away their inside game, but they got hot shooting threes." Camelback connected on 16 treys.

Flagstaff was also big and talented as the Eagles beat Hopi 69-29 in the second round. Jahim Jameer topped Flagstaff with 13 points. Steven Baker led the Bruins with nine points and Nodman netted eight points. "They took it to us right from the get go," Coach Baker said. "Flagstaff is well-coached and they wore us down,"

In the third round against Northwest Christian beat Hopi 57-38. Kendrick James topped Hopi with 11 points, Kyrane Yazzie netted seven and Steven Baker tossed in six.

Coach Baker said the Bruins played pretty well in this game, but Northwest pulled away in the second quarter. "They had big kids who outrebounded us. They had a good inside game and we didn't have the kids to match them," he said.

Coach Baker said the Hopi offense struggled at times, but made a run in the third quarter. "We just couldn't pull it off," he said.

In the opening period, Latrell Lee, Baker and James all hit treys as Hopi trailed only 14-9. Northwest Christian led 28-16 at halftime and 42-28 after three periods before cruising to the victory.

In the fourth round, Payson edged Hopi 70-63. Ryan Riake led Payson with 26 points, Royce Matthews fired in 11 points and Julian Parker netted nine.

Hopi's Yazzie led all scorers with 30 points, Baker netted nine, Jacob Lim finished with eight, Nodman and James scored six points each.

Payson jumped out to a 20-8 lead after the first period, but Hopi came storming back to pull within 33-30 at intermission. Hopi only trailed 50-48 after three quarters. Payson won the fourth quarter by five points to gain the victory.

Coach Baker noted that Hopi went ahead briefly in the third quarter. "But they had a good inside game so we had a lot of fouls," he said.

Payson scored 17 points off of foul shots. "That makes it hard to win," he said. "We got our outside game going with three pointers, but they had too many putbacks."

# Hopi Tribal Council approves Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund Operating Budget for Departments, Programs, Villages and Entities

According to the 2017 Expenditure Authoriza- tion & Appropriations Language, the Hopi Trib- al Council directed BOT to complete a proposed FY 2017 budget with a 12% reduction from the FY 2016 approved bud- get. This was based on the FY 2017 projected decline in tribal revenues. Based on this directive, BOT de- signed a process to meet the directed 12% budget reduction.

The General Fund Bud- get Appropriations request for Fiscal Year 2017 was \$18,445,429.00 and ap- proved by Tribal Council on 12/1/2016 , based on the following: FY2017 revenue projections \$14,649,669.00, plus \$3,795,790.00 to come from the Proceeds of Labor account and;

1. Review of expen- diture reports (to date) for FY2016

2. Review of in- dividual Department/ Program/Entity budget proposal packets con- taining:

a. Program Overview

b. Goals & Measurable Objectives

c. Budget Justifications

d. Salary Sheets

e. Consolidated Budget Summaries

The approved FY2017 General Fund Budget shall be implemented on January 1, 2017. Once approved, the Director of Finance shall issue Charts of Accounts to the respective programs/ Villages/Community within 15 business days.

The Petitioner, Karen Pennington, Deputy General Counsel of the Hopi Tribe alleges that:

Thane Epefania and Michelle A. Epefania are nonmembers of the Hopi Tribe and that Thane and Michelle A. Epefania are now on the Hopi Reservation at Mission School, Kykotsmovi, AZ.

Petitioner alleges that Thane and Michelle Epefania’s presence on the Hopi Indian Reservation is harmful to the members of the Hopi Indian Tribe and therefore they are subject to exclusion and/or removal because:

He/She has entered or remains upon a closed portion of the Hopi Indian Reservation in violation of Ordinance 46; or

He/She has violated another Ordinance or law of the Hopi Indian Tribe or a Hopi Village Ordinance or law; or


XX He/She has violated a law of the United States; or

\_\_\_\_\_ He/She has engaged in conduct that would be a violation of the criminal laws of the Hopi Indian Tribe If he/she were subject to the criminal laws of the Hopi Indian Tribe.

The following is a summary of the facts which support these allegations, including the facts that brought Thane and Michelle A. Epefania to the Petitioner’s attention: In October, 2016, The Hopi Tutuveni published an article stating that Thane and Michelle A. Epefania had been indicted by the grand jury in Flagstaff, AZ for social security fraud and that they are currently under federal fraud charges. A copy of the federal criminal court indictment of the Epefanios is attached. In November 2016, FBI Agent Dan Johnson was encountered by the Vice Chairman of the Hopi Tribe at the Mennonite Church taking statements of members regarding the conduct of the Epefanios. FBI Agent Johnson indicated that further criminal charges may be filed against the Epefanios as a result of his Investigation.

THE PETITIONER REQUESTS THAT THE CHAIRMAN excludes Thane and Michelle A. Epefania from the Hopi Reservation.

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

1.From in or about September 2009, the exact date being unknown to the Grand Jury, and continuing thereafter up to and including December 2015, within the District of Arizona and elsewhere, **THANE EPEFANIO** and **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** did unlawfully, voluntarily, intentionally, and knowingly conspire, combine, confederate, and agree together and with each other, and with other individuals, both known and unknown, to defraud the United States by deceitful and dishonest means for the purpose of impeding, impairing, obstructing, and defeating the lawful government function of the Social Security Administration (“SSA”), in the administration, determination, and of funds through the Disability Insurance Benefits program.

MANNER AND MEANS:

2.Among the manner and means by which **THANE EPEFANIO** and **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** and their co-conspirators carried out the conspiracy were the following:

a. By misrepresenting the nature of **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO**’S disability through the presentation of documentation and other statements.

b. By submitting false documentation to the Social Security Administration in an effort to conceal **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO**’S employment history.

OVERT ACTS

3.In furtherance of the conspiracy, and to effect the objects and purposes thereof, the following overt acts, among others, occurred within the District of Arizona, and elsewhere:

a. In or about September 2009, **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO**, applied for SSA Disability Insurance Benefits advising the SSA that she was disables and unable to work.

b. In or about September 2009, as part of the application procedure **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** represented that if her disability no longer prohibited her from working or if she returned to work, that she would notify the SSA of the change.

c. On or about March 24, 2014, **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** completed an Arizona Driver’s Application and stated that she had to impairment that would effect her ability to drive.

d. In or about May 2014, **THANE EPEFANIO** signed two Forms SSA-L725 indicating that **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** earned no income.

e. On or about November 3, 2015, **THANE EPEFANIO** stated that **MICHELLE A. EPEFANIO** did not receive any income from working.

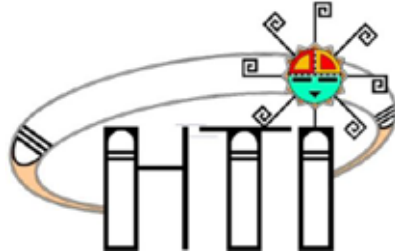
