


Q3 Do you currently live on the Hopi Reservation?


Q4 Did you ever attend school on the Hopi Reservation?

Q5 What school(s) did you attend? (Check all that apply)



Q6 What is your highest level of education?







Q9 Do (or did) any of your children attend Hopi schools?



Q10 Which of the following schools do/did your children attend? (Check all that apply.)



Q11 How satisfied are/were you with the Hopi school(s) your children attend(ed)?







Q17 What should parents and/or other family members do to support the education of Hopi children? (Check all that apply.)








Q22 The Hopi education system should focus more on cultural aspects.

Q23 The Hopi students should be academically competitive with other students in Arizona, and nationally.













Q7 Do you have Internet access at home?













Q6 How do you usually get to school?




