



SPECIAL NOTICE TO THE HOPI COMMUNITY ROUTE SCHEDULE AND POLICY CHANGES IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 March 19, 2020

In keeping with Executive Order #01-2020 and with the likely continued spread of the COVID-19 novel coronavirus, we understand that people may be feeling anxiety and concern about the safety of Hopi Senom Transit; we take this very seriously. Although we have already been doing daily cleaning and disinfecting measures to ensure the safety of our riders and employees, we ask for your utmost cooperation to help us keep providing you with safe transit service.

In order to continue service in a safe and professional manner, we are doing the following:

TRANSIT ROUTE SERVICE

- The Midday Route will not be in service until further notice
- The Flagstaff Route will continue to be out of service until further notice.
- The Winslow, Keams Canyon and Tuba City routes will continue to run on their regular schedules. Be advised route schedules can change due to the rapidly developing COVID-19 situation.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

- The Hopi Senom Transit office will be closed to the public. The Hopi Senom Transit office in Kykotsmovi will continue to provide route information and customer service Monday – Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Be advised office hours can change due to the rapidly developing COVID-19 situation. Call us at 928-734-3232.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- For the safety of our riders and drivers, **YOU CANNOT BOARD THE BUS IF YOU ARE SICK.**
- To promote social distancing, all riders will be asked to board the bus quickly and safely and fill the rear seats first.
- Lost and Found items will not be kept and will be disposed of daily. Cell phones, keys, jewelry, and items of value will be kept for a period of one week. Riders are reminded to keep track of their belongings and check their seats before leaving the bus, Hopi Senom Transit is not responsible for any items left on the bus.
- **DO NOT USE TRANSIT FOR UNNECESSARY TRAVEL.** During this critical time, the Transit will operate for you to go to work, go to a medical appointment or for shopping for necessary items for you or your family. Do not ride the Transit for entertainment, sightseeing or other social purposes.
- **LIMIT ANY TRAVEL if you live with someone who is older or has a serious, chronic medical condition.**
- **Hopi Senom Transit** will be closed on Tuesday, March 24 for staff instruction on disinfecting, sanitizing and deep cleaning of transit vehicles. We will resume service on Wednesday, March 25.

For the safety and the well-being of the Hopi Reservation, these changes shall remain in effect until further notice. Thank You for your cooperation, let's all work together to be safe together.
